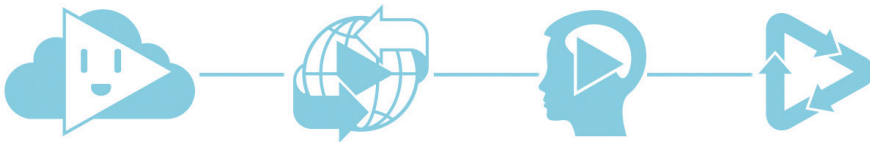

Person-to-Person and Multi-Person High-Definition Video Conferencing

Video Collaboration Powered by Zoom is flexible and allows registered users to participate in person-to-person or multi-person video conference calls, as well as high-definition video conference calls, and invite outside participants and guests to join a conference.

This high-definition video conferencing solution is designed to easily and cost-effectively promote and enable face-to-face distance learning, professional development, meetings, and collaboration using the computing power already present in most computers and mobile devices.

With Video Collaboration Powered by Zoom, users can:

- Host 50 participants within a conference
- Invite guests with or without Video Collaboration Powered by Zoom accounts
- Connect to H.323 legacy equipment and/or HD video
- Share presentations and other desktop-based applications
- Participate in anytime, anywhere video conferencing without making reservations

Video Collaboration Powered by Zoom utilizes best-in-class group collaboration features, including;

- Group and private messaging
- Meeting controls
- The ability to screen share documents, photos, and video clips
- Annotation and co-annotation of shared documents and resources
- Raise hand functionality
- Conference whiteboard
- Keyboard and mouse control
- iPhone/iPad screen share with iOS mirror

Administrative tools at your fingertips include:

- Schedule and conduct large scale meetings
- Manage users and user profiles
- Utilize Google Chrome and Outlook Calendar plug-ins
- Monitor and track reports
- Customize e-mails and communications



Webinar and Large Group Meeting Options and Features

Video Collaboration Powered by Zoom supports large group webinars and meetings. A host may support a one-way meeting via a webinar, or an interactive meeting using large group meeting, with features and options including:

- Webinar options (Host 100, 500, 1,000, or 3,000 participants)
 - One-way presentation with video and content
- Large group meeting options (Host 100 or 200 participants)
 - Two-way interactive meeting with video and content share
- Scheduling ability (schedule webinars and recurring meetings in advance)
- Record and archive events
- Send out invitations and follow-up information
- Polling and chat features
- Support up to 25 active panelists within a webinar
- Promote participants to panelists
- Review and export participant reports

Inviting Guests

In addition to calling other users or classrooms, Video Collaboration Powered by Zoom also makes it possible to video conference with guests. Guests can be parents, teachers, librarians, faculty members in other locations, or other invited guests who do not have an account. Guests are not required to sign up for any service; they simply click an invitation to participate in a video conference call, and they are prompted to automatically download the free video client.

Reservationless Conferencing

Unlike traditional, hardware-based video conferencing services and solutions which have limited ports available for multi-person calling, Video Collaboration Powered by Zoom is designed to be available anytime, anywhere. Users are not required to reserve ports ahead of time for multi-person video conference calls. To initiate or receive person-to-person or multi-person video conference calls, users simply have to log in via their device.

Recording

Video Collaboration Powered by Zoom allows users to record meetings, programs, or events. Recording capabilities are controlled by the user and may be recorded locally or to the cloud. Recorded meetings may be shared with participants or accessed for later review. Record video conferences and meetings as an MP4 or M4A local recording or cloud recording.
